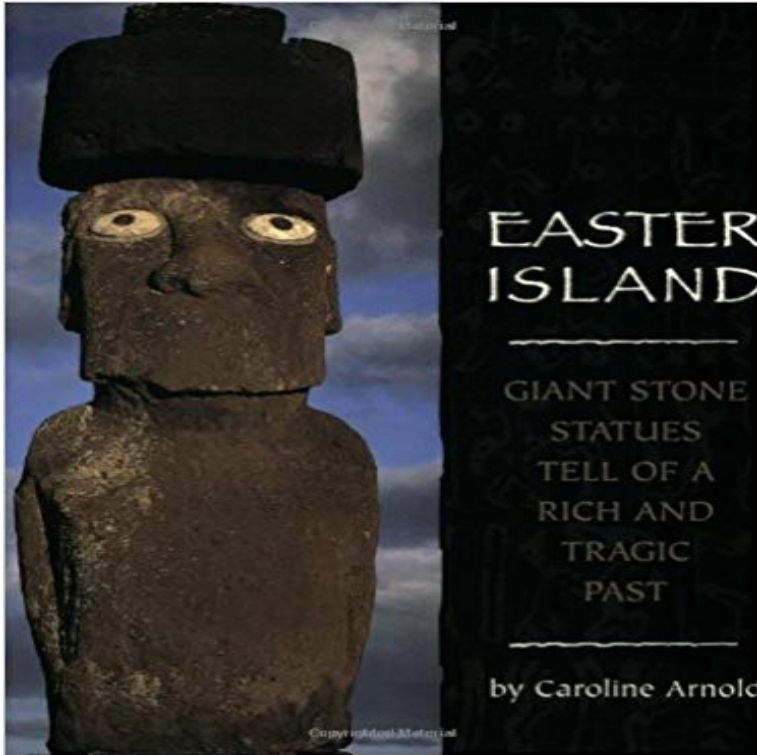


Easter Island: Giant Stone Statues Tell of a Rich and Tragic Past
