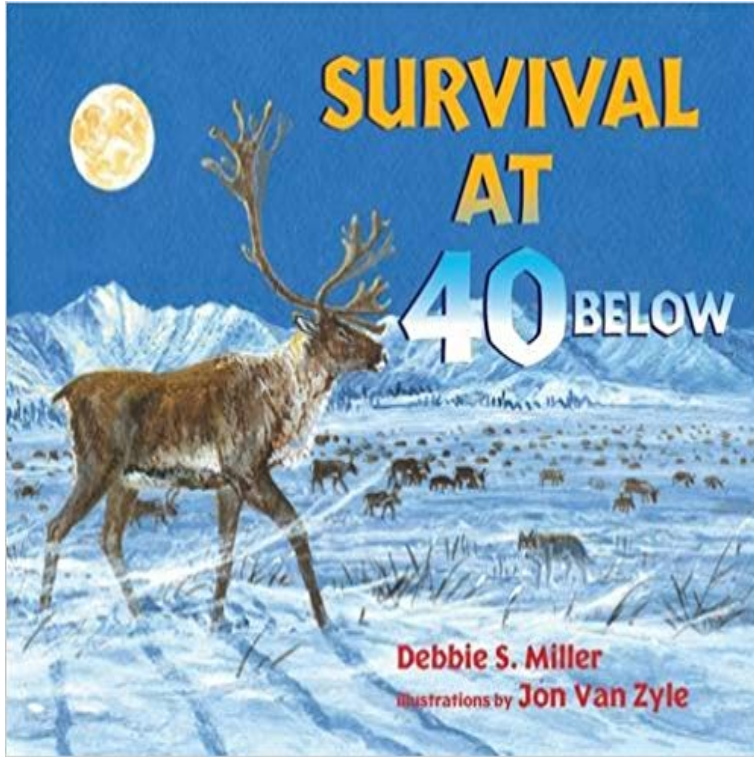


Survival at 40 Below
