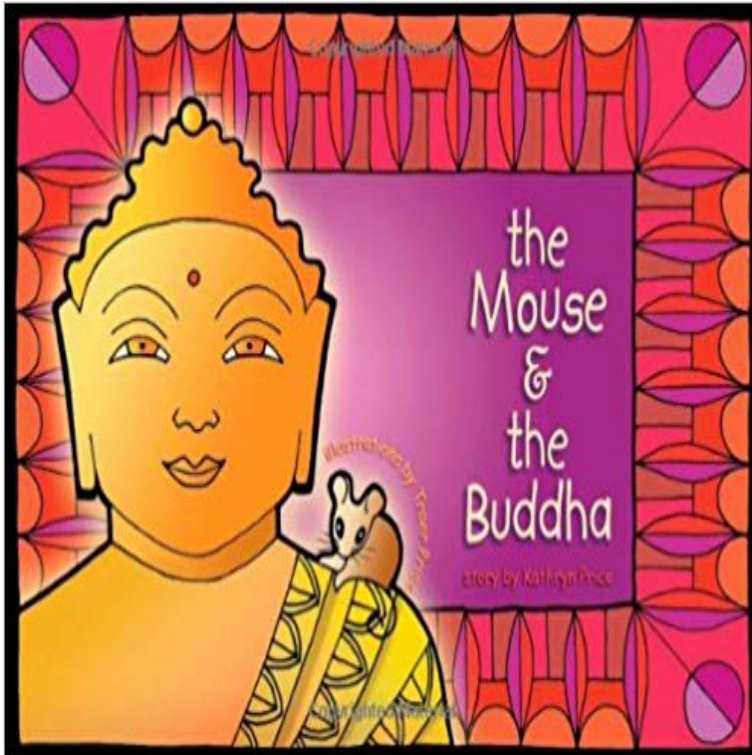


The Mouse & the Buddha
