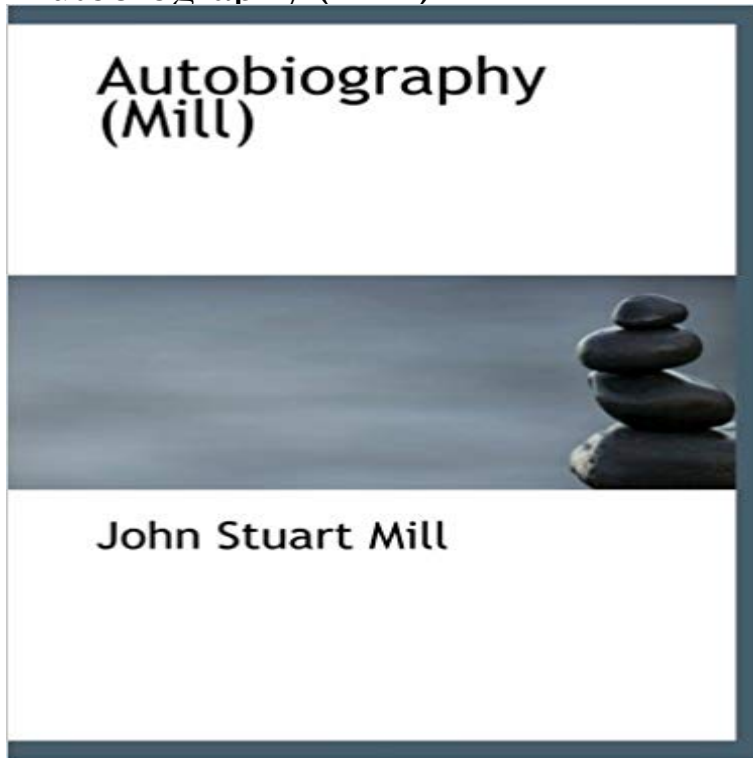


Autobiography (Mill)
